14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

18 (b) (1) For the purpose of all hearings and inquiries which the board is
19 authorized to hold and make, the board may issue summonses for witnesses, and
20 administer to them oaths or affirmations.

21 (2) (i) All summonses shall be served by the sheriff, except that:

22 1. In the City of Annapolis, summonses may also be served
23 by the Annapolis Police Department;

24 2. In Anne Arundel County, summonses may also be served
25 by inspectors employed by the Board and by the Anne Arundel County Police
26 Department;
