4 FOR the purpose of altering the effective date of certain regulations adopted under the
5 Administrative Procedure Act; and generally relating to regulations adopted under
6 the Administrative Procedure Act.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article – State Government
9 Section 10–117
10 Annotated Code of Maryland
11 (2014 Replacement Volume and 2015 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – State Government**

15 10–117.

16 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this section or in other
17 law, the effective date of a regulation is:

1 (I) JANUARY 1 IF THE NOTICE OF ADOPTION IS PUBLISHED IN
2 THE REGISTER DURING THE PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 1 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30,
3 BOTH INCLUSIVE;

4 (II) APRIL 1 IF THE NOTICE OF ADOPTION IS PUBLISHED IN THE
5 REGISTER DURING THE PERIOD FROM DECEMBER 1 THROUGH FEBRUARY 29, BOTH
6 INCLUSIVE;

7 (III) JULY 1 IF THE NOTICE OF ADOPTION IS PUBLISHED IN THE
8 REGISTER DURING THE PERIOD FROM MARCH 1 THROUGH MAY 31, BOTH
9 INCLUSIVE;

10 (IV) OCTOBER 1 IF THE NOTICE OF ADOPTION IS PUBLISHED IN
11 THE REGISTER DURING THE PERIOD FROM JUNE 1 THROUGH AUGUST 31, BOTH
12 INCLUSIVE;

13 [(i)] (v) the 10th calendar day after notice of adoption is published
14 in the Register IF:

15 1. THE UNIT IS REQUIRED TO ADOPT THE PROPOSED
16 REGULATION BY FEDERAL LAW;

17 2. THE REGULATION RELATES TO AIR POLLUTION;

18 3. THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL
19 HYGIENE OR THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, LICENSING, AND REGULATION IS
20 REQUIRED BY STATE LAW TO ADOPT THE REGULATION ON OR BEFORE A SPECIFIED
21 DATE WITHIN 12 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LAW;

22 4. THE REGULATION RELATES TO THE MARYLAND
23 MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER TITLE 15 OF THE HEALTH
24 – GENERAL ARTICLE;

25 5. THE REGULATION RELATES TO THE
26 IMPLEMENTATION OF FEDERAL HEALTH CARE REFORM UNDER THE FEDERAL
27 PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE ACT;

9 (2) For calculation of the effective date under this subsection:

10 (i) § 1-302 of the General Provisions Article does not apply;

11 (ii) the issue date of the Register in which the notice is published is
12 not counted; and

13 (iii) each other calendar day, including Saturdays, Sundays, and
14 legal holidays, is counted.

15 (b) The effective date of a regulation after its emergency adoption is the date that
16 the Committee sets.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 2016.
