AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 300, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments (SB0300/974234/1), in line 20 of Amendment No. 1, after “dates;” insert “making this Act subject to a certain contingency;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 8 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments, in line 18 of Amendment No. 4, after “Committee” insert “.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this Act are contingent on the Department of Agriculture adopting regulations, on or before October 1, 2020, that ban the use of chlorpyrifos in the State by December 31, 2021.

(b) On or before October 1, 2020, the Department of Agriculture shall notify the Department of Legislative Services whether regulations have been adopted that ban the use of chlorpyrifos in the State by December 31, 2021.

(c) (1) If the Department of Legislative Services receives notification that the Department of Agriculture has failed to adopt the regulations on or before October 1, 2020, Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this Act shall take effect on the date the notice is received by the Department of Legislative Services in accordance with subsection (b) of this section.

(2) If the Department of Legislative Services receives notice that the Department of Agriculture has adopted regulations on or before October 1, 2020,

Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be null and void”;

and in line 19 of Amendment No. 4, strike “4.” and substitute “5.”.

On page 2 of the bill, in line 2, after “That” insert “, subject to Section 4 of this Act.”.
