BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 4–205.1(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments. Article – Natural Resources Section 4-205.1(b) and 4-701.1Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
