A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages – Board Meetings**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel
4 County to publish a meeting agenda a certain amount of time before a meeting;
5 requiring the Board to broadcast every open meeting online; altering the timing
6 requirement for publication of meeting minutes; and generally relating to alcoholic
7 beverages in Anne Arundel County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

21 11–102.

22 This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

1 **(A) THE BOARD SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC THE AGENDA FOR**
2 **AN UPCOMING MEETING NOT LESS THAN 1 WEEK BEFORE THE MEETING.**

3 **(B) THE BOARD SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC LIVE VIDEO AND**
4 **AUDIO STREAMING OF EACH OPEN MEETING.**

5 **(C) IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 3-306 OF THE GENERAL PROVISIONS ARTICLE,**
6 **THE BOARD SHALL PUBLISH THE MINUTES OF EACH OPEN MEETING NOT LATER**
7 **THAN 1 MONTH AFTER THE MEETING.**

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2020.
