A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Towing or Removal of Vehicles From Parking Lots – Reclamation Hours**

3 FOR the purpose of limiting the hours during which a certain person in possession of a
4 vehicle that has been towed or removed from a parking lot is required to provide an
5 opportunity for the vehicle owner or the owner's agent to retake possession of the
6 vehicle; altering a certain signage requirement imposed on the owner or operator of
7 a parking lot relating to hours during which a towed vehicle may be reclaimed; and
8 generally relating to retaking possession of towed vehicles.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Transportation**

17 21–10A–02.

18 (a) The owner or operator of a parking lot or the owner's or operator's agent may
19 not have a vehicle towed or otherwise removed from the parking lot unless the owner,
20 operator, or agent has placed in conspicuous locations, as described in subsection (b) of this
21 section, signs that:

22 (4) State that State law requires that the vehicle be available for
23 reclamation [24 hours per day] **FROM 6 A.M. TO MIDNIGHT**, 7 days per week;

2 (a) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, if a vehicle is towed or otherwise
3 removed from a parking lot, the person in possession of the vehicle:

4 (1) Shall immediately deliver the vehicle directly to the storage facility
5 stated on the signs posted in accordance with § 21-10A-02 of this subtitle;

6 (2) May not move the towed vehicle from that storage facility to another
7 storage facility for at least 72 hours; and

8 (3) Shall provide the owner of the vehicle or the owner's agent immediate
9 and continuous opportunity, [24 hours per day] **FROM 6 A.M. TO MIDNIGHT**, 7 days per
10 week, from the time the vehicle was received at the storage facility, to retake possession of
11 the vehicle.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2020.
