RE: SB 11 – Baltimore County – Alcoholic Beverages – Board of License Commissioners – Qualifications

Dear Chairman Pinsky and Members of the Committee:

I am pleased to introduce Senate Bill 11 which will simply require that each member of the Baltimore County Liquor Board must be a resident of the County.

Currently, the counties of Anne Arundel, Frederick, Harford, Howard, Montgomery, and Prince Georges all require that their Liquor Board members reside in their respective counties. Baltimore City also requires this of its liquor board members. This legislation will simply institute the same local residence requirements in Baltimore County.

I ask the committee for a favorable report.
