- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "CONTROLLED ACCESS" MEANS THAT SCHOOL 21 STAFF HAS THE ABILITY TO:

- 6 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW SCHOOLS
 7 OR THE RENOVATION OF EXISTING SCHOOLS THAT HAVE NOT INITIATED A
 8 REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR THE SELECTION OF AN ARCHITECTURAL AND
 9 ENGINEERING CONSULTANT ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2014.
- 10 (C) A NEW SCHOOL OR A RENOVATED SCHOOL THAT RECEIVES STATE
 11 PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION FUNDS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED OR
 12 RENOVATED TO HAVE CONTROLLED ACCESS TO ALLOW VISITORS TO ENTER THE
 13 SCHOOL.
- 14 (D) THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO 15 IMPLEMENT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
