A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Family Investment Program – State Government Hiring Plans – Application**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that certain requirements for developing and
4 implementing a certain plan for the hiring by principal departments of State
5 government of certain recipients and children of certain recipients under the
6 Family Investment Program, foster youth, and obligors do not apply to the
7 Department of Transportation; and generally relating to certain governmental
8 hiring plans and the Family Investment Program.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Human Services**

17 5–304.

18 (b) (1) **(I)** The Secretary of Budget and Management, with the
19 assistance of the Secretary, shall develop and implement a plan for hiring current and
20 former recipients, children of current or former recipients, foster youth, and obligors
21 by the principal departments within the Executive Branch of State government.

22 **(II) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE**
23 **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.**

1 (2) For each principal department, the plan shall include:

2 (i) the units that most easily could hire current and former
3 recipients, children of current or former recipients, foster youth, and obligors;

4 (ii) the positions most suitable for current and former
5 recipients, children of current or former recipients, foster youth, and obligors;

6 (iii) a proposal for recruiting current and former recipients,
7 children of current or former recipients, foster youth, and obligors;

8 (iv) job retention strategies; and

9 (v) a target number of current and former recipients, children of
10 current or former recipients, foster youth, and obligors to be recruited.

11 (3) In consultation with the Secretary, the Secretary of Budget and
12 Management shall report, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the
13 Senate Finance Committee and the House Appropriations Committee of the General
14 Assembly:

15 (i) on or before January 1, 2010, on the development of the
16 hiring plan for current and former recipients, children of current or former recipients,
17 foster youth, and obligors; and

18 (ii) on or before November 1 of each year, on the number of
19 recipients, children of current or former recipients, foster youth, and obligors hired
20 and retained by the principal departments within the Executive Branch of State
21 government.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 July 1, 2013.
