5 FOR the purpose of requiring the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to  
6 notify certain local governments and include notice on the Commission's Web  
7 site about a sewage leak under certain circumstances; requiring the  
8 Commission to adopt regulations to implement this Act; and generally relating  
9 to notice requirements about sewage leaks and the Washington Suburban  
10 Sanitary Commission.

12 Article – Public Utilities

13 Section 24–202 to be under the amended subtitle “Subtitle 2. Sewer Cleaning

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Public Utilities**

20 **Subtitle 2. Sewer Cleaning AND SEWAGE LEAKS.**

2 (A) WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE DISCOVERY OF A LEAK IN A SANITARY  
3 SEWER LINE, PIPE, OR FIXTURE THAT IS CONNECTED TO THE SANITARY SEWER  
4 SYSTEM OF THE COMMISSION, THE COMMISSION SHALL:

5 (1) NOTIFY THE COUNTY AND ANY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN  
6 WHICH THE SEWAGE LEAK IS LOCATED ABOUT:

7 (I) THE SEWAGE LEAK; AND

8 (II) THE COMMISSION'S INTENDED ACTION CONCERNING  
9 THE SEWAGE LEAK; AND

10 (2) INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ON THE COMMISSION'S WEB SITE:

11 (I) NOTICE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC ABOUT THE SEWAGE  
12 LEAK; AND

13 (II) THE PHONE NUMBER FOR OBTAINING ADDITIONAL  
14 INFORMATION FROM THE COMMISSION.

15 (B) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT  
16 THIS SECTION.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
18 October 1, 2013.
