## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Birds – Oriole and Raven**

3 FOR the purpose of making the raven the second State bird of Maryland.

4 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
5 Article – State Government  
6 Section 13–302  
7 Annotated Code of Maryland  
8 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

11 **Article – State Government**

12 13–302.

13 The Baltimore Oriole (*Icterus galbula*) [is] **AND THE RAVEN (CORVUS CORAX)**  
14 **ARE** the State [bird] **BIRDS**.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
16 October 1, 2013.
