A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Gas Pipelines – Construction Requirements**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a gas transmission company from beginning
4 construction on a gas pipeline before the finalization of certain legal
5 proceedings, including approval by the Board of Public Works, permit and
6 license applications, condemnation proceedings, easement negotiations, and
7 appeals to certain judgments and determinations; defining certain terms; and
8 generally relating to the construction of gas pipelines.

9 BY adding to

10 Article – Public Safety

11 Section 15–101 and 15–102 to be under the new title “Title 15. Gas Pipeline
12 Safety”

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Public Safety**

18 **TITLE 15. GAS PIPELINE SAFETY.**

19 **15–101.**

20 (A) IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
21 INDICATED.

22 (B) (1) “CONSTRUCTION” MEANS:

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (I) ANY PHYSICAL CHANGE AT A SITE, INCLUDING
2 FABRICATION, ERECTION, INSTALLATION, OR DEMOLITION; OR

3 (II) THE ENTRY INTO A BINDING AGREEMENT OR
4 CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATION TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT EXCLUSIVELY FOR USE
5 IN CONSTRUCTION IN THE STATE OR TO UNDERTAKE A PROGRAM OF ACTUAL
6 CONSTRUCTION IN THE STATE THAT CANNOT BE CANCELED OR MODIFIED
7 WITHOUT SUBSTANTIAL LOSS TO THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF THE PROPOSED
8 GAS PIPELINE.

9 (2) "CONSTRUCTION" DOES NOT INCLUDE A CHANGE THAT IS
10 NEEDED FOR THE TEMPORARY USE OF A SITE OR ROUTE FOR NONUTILITY
11 PURPOSES OR FOR USE IN SECURING GEOLOGICAL DATA, INCLUDING ANY
12 BORING THAT IS NECESSARY TO ASCERTAIN FOUNDATION CONDITIONS.

13 (C) "GAS" MEANS NATURAL GAS, FLAMMABLE GAS, OR TOXIC OR
14 CORROSIVE GAS.

15 (D) "GAS PIPELINE" MEANS AN INTRASTATE TRANSMISSION LINE OR
16 ANY PORTION OF AN INTERSTATE TRANSMISSION LINE LOCATED WITHIN THE
17 STATE THAT:

18 (1) TRANSPORTS GAS FROM A GATHERING LINE OR STORAGE
19 FACILITY TO A DISTRIBUTION CENTER, STORAGE FACILITY, OR LARGE VOLUME
20 CUSTOMER THAT IS NOT DOWNSTREAM FROM A DISTRIBUTION CENTER;

21 (2) OPERATES AT A HOOP STRESS OF 20% OR MORE OF THE
22 SPECIFIED MINIMUM YIELD STRENGTH OF THE PIPELINE; OR

23 (3) TRANSPORTS GAS WITHIN A STORAGE FIELD.

24 (E) (1) "GAS TRANSMISSION COMPANY" MEANS A PERSON WHO OWNS
25 OR OPERATES A GAS PIPELINE REGULATED UNDER THIS TITLE.

26 (2) "GAS TRANSMISSION COMPANY" DOES NOT INCLUDE A
27 PERSON WHO IS PRIMARILY IN THE BUSINESS OF LOCAL GAS DISTRIBUTION.

28 15-102.

29 A GAS TRANSMISSION COMPANY MAY NOT BEGIN CONSTRUCTION ON A
30 GAS PIPELINE UNTIL THE FINALIZATION OF ALL LEGAL PROCEEDINGS
31 RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INCLUDING:

- 1 **(1) APPROVAL BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS;**
- 2 **(2) PERMIT AND LICENSE APPLICATIONS;**
- 3 **(3) CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS;**
- 4 **(4) EASEMENT NEGOTIATIONS; AND**
- 5 **(5) APPEALS TO ANY JUDGMENTS OR DETERMINATIONS**
6 **RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROPOSED GAS PIPELINE.**

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2013.
