## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Hours of Sale for Golf Course**  
3 **Licenses**

4 **PG 318–13**

5 FOR the purpose of altering the hours of sale for beer and wine under a special 7–day  
6 Class B–GC (golf course) on–sale beer and wine license in Prince George's  
7 County; and generally relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages on golf courses  
8 in Prince George's County.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
10 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages  
11 Section 8–505  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (2011 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

17 8–505.

18 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

1                   (2)    “Board” means the Prince George’s County Board of License  
2 Commissioners.

3                   (3)    “Commission” means the Maryland–National Capital Park and  
4 Planning Commission.

5           (b)    (1)    The Board may issue special 7–day Class B–GC (golf course)  
6 on–sale beer and wine licenses for the exclusive use on the premises of the  
7 Commission’s golf courses located within Prince George’s County.

8                   (2)    The special 7–day Class B–GC on–sale beer and wine license  
9 authorizes the holder to sell beer and wine from 1 or more outlets for consumption on  
10 the premises of the golf course.

11                   (3)    (i)    A separate license is required for each applicable golf course.

12                               (ii)   A special 7–day Class B–GC on–sale beer and wine license  
13 shall be issued to each of the managers of the Commission’s golf courses upon making  
14 application and qualifying as a license holder under this article.

15                   (4)    (i)    Except as provided in this subsection, the hours of sale for  
16 beer and wine under this license are from [11 a.m.] **9 A.M.** to 10 p.m. daily, Monday  
17 through Sunday.

18                               (ii)   The Commission may:

19                                       1.    Reduce the hours of sale of beer and wine under this  
20 license; and

21                                       2.    Discontinue the sale of beer and wine under this  
22 license from Labor Day through Memorial Day.

23                   (5)    The annual fee for a special 7–day Class B–GC on–sale beer and  
24 wine license is \$365.

25           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
26 July 1, 2013.
