CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Circuit Court Clerks – Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering a certain limit on the maximum salary that the Board of
4 Public Works may set for a clerk of a circuit court; providing that this Act does
5 not apply to the salary or compensation of an incumbent clerk of a circuit court
6 during a certain term of office; and generally relating to the salary of a clerk of a
7 circuit court.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

16 2–504.

17 (a) The clerk of each circuit court shall receive an annual salary of not more
18 than ~~[\$98,500]~~ **\$114,500** as set by the Board of Public Works on the basis of the
19 relative volume of business and receipts in the clerk’s office.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
2 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
3 the salary or compensation of the clerk of a circuit court during a term of office
4 beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning
5 the salary or compensation of the clerk of a circuit court shall take effect at the
6 beginning of the next following term of office.

7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2013.
