A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Senior Higher Education Institutions – Institution Management –**
3 **Admissions Requirements**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring each public senior higher education institution to
5 maintain its total student body in a certain manner; and generally relating to
6 admission requirements for public senior higher education institutions.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Education**

15 **12–104.2.**

16 **EXCLUDING ALL STUDENTS ENROLLED EXCLUSIVELY IN DISTANCE**
17 **EDUCATION PROGRAMS, EACH PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION**
18 **INSTITUTION SHALL MAINTAIN ITS TOTAL STUDENT BODY IN ACCORDANCE WITH**
19 **THE FOLLOWING:**

20 **(1) THE NUMBER OF OUT-OF-STATE UNDERGRADUATE**
21 **STUDENTS MAY NOT EXCEED 20% OF ITS TOTAL UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT**
22 **BODY;**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(2) THE NUMBER OF OUT-OF-STATE GRADUATE STUDENTS MAY**
2 **NOT EXCEED 30% OF ITS TOTAL GRADUATE STUDENT BODY; AND**

3 **(3) THE NUMBER OF OUT-OF-STATE GRADUATE STUDENTS IN**
4 **EACH ACADEMIC SCHOOL OR DISCIPLINE MAY NOT EXCEED 30% OF THE**
5 **ACADEMIC SCHOOL OR DISCIPLINE'S TOTAL GRADUATE STUDENT ENROLLMENT.**

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 July 1, 2013.
