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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Commission on the Establishment of a Maryland Educators Service**  
3 **Memorial**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Commission on the Establishment of a Maryland  
5 Educators Service Memorial; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing  
6 of the Commission; requiring that the members of the Commission be appointed  
7 on or before a certain date; prohibiting a member of the Commission from  
8 receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain  
9 expenses; specifying the duties of the Commission; requiring the Commission to  
10 report its initial findings and recommendations to the Governor and the  
11 General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of  
12 this Act; and generally relating to the Commission on the Establishment of a  
13 Maryland Educators Service Memorial.

14 Preamble

15 WHEREAS, Maryland educators dedicate their lives on a daily basis in service  
16 to the learning, care, safety, and future of the children in the State; and

1 WHEREAS, Educators are committed to nurturing the intellectual growth and  
2 character development of Maryland's children and, because of their work, instill in the  
3 children a spirit of lifelong learning and good citizenship that enriches the State; and

4 WHEREAS, Educators provide a safe and welcoming learning environment that  
5 honors every child, their heritage, and their contributions; and

6 WHEREAS, The State recognizes the heroic service of educators in response to  
7 the tragedies of school violence and, in doing so, also seeks to recognize the everyday  
8 heroic acts shown through the dedication, compassion, and commitment of educators  
9 across the State; and

10 WHEREAS, The creation of the Maryland Educators Service Memorial would  
11 recognize the sacrifices, commitment, dedication, and contribution of all Maryland  
12 educators past, present, and future, and ensure that their service to the State and its  
13 children will be remembered and honored; now, therefore,

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That:

16 (a) There is a Commission on the Establishment of a Maryland Educators  
17 Service Memorial.

18 (b) The Commission consists of the following members:

19 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the  
20 President of the Senate;

21 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker  
22 of the House;

23 (3) the Secretary of General Services, or the Secretary's designee;

24 (4) the State Superintendent of Education, or the Superintendent's  
25 designee;

26 (5) a member of the State Board of Education, appointed by the  
27 President of the Board; and

28 (6) the following members, appointed by the Governor:

29 (i) two retired educators who are residents of the State and who  
30 taught in the State; and

31 (ii) two educators who are residents of the State and who are  
32 actively employed in the State.

1 (c) The members of the Commission shall be appointed on or before July 15,  
2 2013.

3 (d) The President and the Speaker shall appoint a Senator and a Delegate,  
4 respectively, to serve as cochairs.

5 (e) The State Department of Education shall provide staff for the  
6 Commission.

7 (f) A member of the Commission:

8 (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Commission; but

9 (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard  
10 State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

11 (g) The Commission shall:

12 (1) identify an appropriate site on property located within the State  
13 Capitol Complex or another appropriate site in Annapolis in close proximity to the  
14 State Capitol Complex for the location of a Maryland Educators Service Memorial;

15 (2) estimate the total funding required for the design, construction,  
16 and appropriate placement of the memorial;

17 (3) consider preliminary design ideas for the construction of the  
18 memorial;

19 (4) make recommendations regarding an appropriate site for the  
20 location of the memorial and the design of the memorial; and

21 (5) provide ongoing review and recommendations regarding the  
22 funding and construction of the memorial.

23 (h) On or before December 1, 2013, the Commission shall report its initial  
24 findings and recommendations to the Governor for possible inclusion in the Fiscal  
25 Year 2015 Operating and Capital Budgets and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the  
26 State Government Article, to the General Assembly.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
28 June 1, 2013. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of May  
29 31, 2016, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be  
30 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
