2 **Family Law – Protective Orders – Notification of Service – Sunset Extension**

3 FOR the purpose of extending the termination date of certain provisions of law that
4 provide for notice of the service on a respondent of certain protective orders; and
5 generally relating to notification of the service of a protective order.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

7 Chapter 711 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2009, as amended by

8 Chapter 103 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2011

9 Section 2

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Chapter 711 of the Acts of 2009, as amended by Chapter 103 of the Acts of**
13 **2011**

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 January 1, 2010, contingent on the receipt by the Governor's Office of Crime Control
16 and Prevention of federal funds under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act
17 of 2009 to fund implementation of the notification requirements under this Act and if
18 federal funds are not received for this purpose by January 1, 2010, this Act shall be
19 null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly. It shall
20 remain effective for a period of [4] ~~6~~ 7 years and, at the end of December 31, [2013]
