2 **Prince George's County – State's Attorney – Salary**

3 **PG 310–14**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the annual salary of the State's Attorney of Prince
5 George's County; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or
6 compensation of the State's Attorney of Prince George's County while serving in
7 a certain term of office; providing that a certain limitation does not apply to a
8 certain individual; and generally relating to the salary of the State's Attorney of
9 Prince George's County.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article – Criminal Procedure**

3 (a) This section applies only in Prince George’s County.

4 (b) (1) [The State’s Attorney’s salary is \$150,000] **THE STATE’S**
5 **ATTORNEY SHALL RECEIVE AN ANNUAL SALARY OF:**6 (I) **\$195,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2015;**7 (II) **\$201,250 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2016;**8 (III) **\$207,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2017;**9 (IV) **\$213,750 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2018; AND**10 (V) **\$220,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2019 AND EACH YEAR**
11 **THEREAFTER.**12 (2) The State’s Attorney’s salary and expenses shall be paid in equal
13 semimonthly installments.14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
15 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
16 the salary or compensation of the State’s Attorney of Prince George’s County while
17 serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the
18 provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the State’s Attorney of
19 Prince George’s County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of
20 office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the
21 effective date of this Act to fill an expired term.22 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2014.
