2 **Health Insurance – Incentives for Health Care Practitioners**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the circumstances under which a health insurance carrier
4 is not prohibited from providing bonuses or other incentive-based compensation
5 to a health care practitioner or a set of health care practitioners; defining a
6 certain term; and generally relating to incentives for health care practitioners
7 under health insurance.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Insurance

15–113.

(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(2) “Carrier” means:

(i) an insurer;

(ii) a nonprofit health service plan;

(iii) a health maintenance organization;

(iv) a dental plan organization; or

(v) any other person that provides health benefit plans subject to regulation by the State.

(3) “Health care practitioner” means an individual who is licensed, certified, or otherwise authorized under the Health Occupations Article to provide health care services.

(b) A carrier may not reimburse a health care practitioner in an amount less than the sum or rate negotiated in the carrier’s provider contract with the health care practitioner.

(c) **(1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, “SET OF HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONERS” MEANS:**

(I) A GROUP PRACTICE;

(II) A CLINICALLY INTEGRATED ORGANIZATION ESTABLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBTITLE 19 OF THIS TITLE; OR

(III) AN ACCOUNTABLE CARE ORGANIZATION ESTABLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 42 U.S.C. § 1899 AND ANY APPLICABLE FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

(2) This section does not prohibit a carrier from providing bonuses or other incentive-based compensation to a health care practitioner OR A SET OF HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONERS if the bonus or other incentive-based compensation:

 2 **OF MEDICALLY APPROPRIATE OR MEDICALLY NECESSARY HEALTH CARE**

 5 **ORGANIZATION,** complies with the provisions of § 19-705.1 of the Health – General

19 **(3) A BONUS OR OTHER INCENTIVE-BASED COMPENSATION**
 20 **UNDER THIS SUBSECTION:**

21 **(I) IF APPLICABLE, SHALL PROMOTE THE PROVISION OF**
 22 **PREVENTIVE HEALTH CARE SERVICES; OR**

23 **(II) MAY REWARD A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER OR A SET**
 24 **OF HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONERS, BASED ON SATISFACTION OF PERFORMANCE**
 25 **MEASURES, IF THE FOLLOWING IS AGREED ON IN WRITING BY THE CARRIER AND**
 26 **THE HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER OR SET OF HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONERS:**

27 **1. THE PERFORMANCE MEASURES;**

28 **2. THE METHOD FOR CALCULATING WHETHER THE**
 29 **PERFORMANCE MEASURES HAVE BEEN SATISFIED; AND**

30 **3. THE METHOD BY WHICH THE HEALTH CARE**
 31 **PRACTITIONER OR SET OF HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONERS MAY REQUEST**
 32 **RECONSIDERATION OF THE CALCULATIONS BY THE CARRIER.**

1 **(4) ACCEPTANCE OF A BONUS OR OTHER INCENTIVE-BASED**
2 **COMPENSATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE VOLUNTARY.**

3 **(5) A CARRIER MAY NOT REQUIRE A HEALTH CARE**
4 **PRACTITIONER OR A SET OF HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONERS TO PARTICIPATE IN**
5 **THE CARRIER’S BONUS OR INCENTIVE-BASED COMPENSATION PROGRAM AS A**
6 **CONDITION OF PARTICIPATION IN THE CARRIER’S PROVIDER NETWORK.**

7 **(6) A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER, A SET OF HEALTH CARE**
8 **PRACTITIONERS, A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER’S DESIGNEE, OR A DESIGNEE**
9 **OF A SET OF HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONERS MAY FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE**
10 **ADMINISTRATION REGARDING A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBSECTION.**

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2014.
