A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Children in Out-of-Home Placement – Annual Notice of Benefits**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Social Services Administration to provide a certain
4 child in out-of-home placement certain information at least once a year;
5 specifying the contents of the information; authorizing the Administration to
6 provide the information to the child at a certain hearing or by certified mail;
7 and generally relating to children in out-of-home placement.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Family Law**

16 5–525.

17 **(K) (1) AT LEAST ONE TIME EACH YEAR, THE ADMINISTRATION**
18 **SHALL PROVIDE A CHILD IN AN OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENT WHO IS AT LEAST 13**
19 **YEARS OLD INFORMATION REGARDING BENEFITS AVAILABLE TO THE CHILD ON**
20 **LEAVING OUT-OF-HOME CARE.**

1 **(2) THE INFORMATION PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF**
2 **THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE INFORMATION REGARDING TUITION**
3 **ASSISTANCE, HEALTH CARE BENEFITS, AND JOB TRAINING AND INTERNSHIP**
4 **OPPORTUNITIES.**

5 **(3) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY PROVIDE THE CHILD THE**
6 **INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION:**

7 **(I) AT A PERMANENCY PLANNING HEARING OR REVIEW**
8 **HEARING HELD IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 3-823 OF THE COURTS ARTICLE; OR**

9 **(II) BY CERTIFIED MAIL.**

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2014.
