1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Rules of the Road – Use of High Occupancy Vehicle**
3 **(HOV) Lanes**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from driving a vehicle in a high occupancy
5 vehicle (HOV) lane except under certain circumstances; authorizing certain
6 vehicles to be driven in HOV lanes at all times; defining a certain term; and
7 generally relating to the use of HOV lanes.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Transportation**

16 **21–314.**

17 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “HOV LANE” MEANS A HIGH OCCUPANCY**
18 **VEHICLE LANE, THE USE OF WHICH IS RESTRICTED BY A TRAFFIC CONTROL**

1 DEVICE DURING SPECIFIED TIMES TO VEHICLES CARRYING AT LEAST A
2 SPECIFIED NUMBER OF OCCUPANTS.

3 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A
4 PERSON MAY NOT DRIVE A VEHICLE IN AN HOV LANE UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY
5 A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE.

6 (C) THE FOLLOWING VEHICLES MAY BE DRIVEN IN AN HOV LANE AT
7 ALL TIMES REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF PASSENGERS IN OR ON THE
8 VEHICLE:

9 (1) A BUS;

10 (2) A MOTORCYCLE; AND

11 (3) A PLUG-IN ELECTRIC DRIVE VEHICLE DISPLAYING A VALID
12 PERMIT ISSUED UNDER § 25-108 OF THIS ARTICLE.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2014.
