## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Inspection of Public Records – Internal Investigations Division of the**  
3 **Baltimore Police Department**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain custodian to permit inspection of a complaint  
5 filed with the Internal Investigations Division of the Baltimore Police  
6 Department and certain documents relating to the complaint; and generally  
7 relating to inspection of public records.

8 BY adding to

9 Article – State Government  
10 Section 10–613.1  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – State Government**

16 **10–613.1.**

17 **NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A CUSTODIAN SHALL**  
18 **PERMIT INSPECTION OF A COMPLAINT FILED WITH OR INVESTIGATED BY THE**  
19 **INTERNAL INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION OF THE BALTIMORE POLICE**  
20 **DEPARTMENT AND ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING TO THE COMPLAINT,**  
21 **INCLUDING:**

22 **(1) DOCUMENTS COLLECTED OR CREATED DURING THE**  
23 **INVESTIGATION OF THE COMPLAINT; AND**

3                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
4 October 1, 2014.
