1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Injuries Compensation Board – Membership – Family Member of**  
3 **Homicide Victim**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Criminal Injuries Compensation  
5 Board to include one person who is a family member of a homicide victim; and  
6 generally relating to the membership of the Criminal Injuries Compensation  
7 Board.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Criminal Procedure**

4 11–804.

5 (a) There is a Criminal Injuries Compensation Board in the Department.

6 (b) (1) The Board consists of five members.

7 (2) Of the five members of the Board:

8 (i) **ONE SHALL BE A FAMILY MEMBER OF A HOMICIDE**  
9 **VICTIM;**

10 **(II)** no more than four may belong to the same political party;  
11 and

12 **[(ii)] (III)** one shall have been admitted to practice law in the  
13 State for at least 5 years immediately preceding the appointment.

14 (3) The Secretary shall appoint the members of the Board, with the  
15 approval of the Governor and the advice and consent of the Senate.

16 (c) (1) The term of a member is 5 years.

17 (2) A member who is appointed to fill a vacancy occurring other than  
18 by expiration of a term serves for the rest of the unexpired term.

19 (d) (1) With the approval of the Governor, the Secretary shall designate  
20 one member of the Board as chairman.

21 (2) The chairman serves at the pleasure of the Secretary.

22 (e) (1) Each member of the Board shall devote the time necessary to  
23 perform the duties listed under this subtitle.

24 (2) Each member of the Board is entitled to:

25 (i) compensation in accordance with the State budget; and

26 (ii) reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State  
27 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

1           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
2   October 1, 2014.
