A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Early–In Early–Out Education Act of 2014**

3 FOR the purpose of including students who graduated from high school before a
4 certain grade in the definition of “full–time equivalent enrollment” for the
5 purpose of certain State education aid calculations; restricting the use of certain
6 funds for the purpose of expanding prekindergarten programs for certain
7 children; repealing an obsolete provision; and generally relating to State
8 education aid.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 (i) The number of students enrolled in grades 1 through 12 or
2 their equivalent in regular day school programs on September 30 of the previous
3 school year;

4 (ii) [Except as provided in item (iii) of this paragraph, the
5 product of the] **THE** number of students enrolled in kindergarten programs on
6 September 30 of the prior school year [and:

- 7 1. 0.60 in fiscal year 2004;
8 2. 0.70 in fiscal year 2005;
9 3. 0.80 in fiscal year 2006;
10 4. 0.90 in fiscal year 2007; and
11 5. 1.00 in fiscal year 2008 and each fiscal year
12 thereafter];

13 (iii) [In Garrett County, the number of students enrolled in
14 kindergarten programs on September 30 of the prior school year; and

15 (iv)] The number of full-time equivalent students, as determined
16 by a regulation of the Department, enrolled in evening high school programs during
17 the previous school year; **AND**

18 **(IV) THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO GRADUATED FROM**
19 **HIGH SCHOOL BEFORE GRADE 12 IN THE PREVIOUS SCHOOL YEAR.**

20 (b) **(1)** Subject to the other provisions of this section **AND SUBJECT TO**
21 **THE LIMITATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION**, each year the
22 State shall distribute the State share of the foundation program to each county board.

23 **(2) THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS RESULTING FROM SUBSECTION**
24 **(A)(6)(IV) OF THIS SECTION MAY BE USED BY THE COUNTY BOARD ONLY TO**

31 **PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION,** the State shall distribute guaranteed tax
32 base grants to county boards as provided in this section.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 July 1, 2014.
