Towson High School Sports Boosters is an all-volunteer organization of parents who fund-raise, promote and support the athletic department at Towson High School. Our 501(c)(3) account number is 3120462				

**11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit Length to Visible area)

This project is to replace the existing scoreboard in the stadium of Towson High School. The current scoreboard is 19 years old with outdated technology, making it difficult to find replacement parts for and expensive to service. The proposed score board will use LED bulbs, fiber optics and a wireless connection to the controller with a 1 year on site and 4yr extended warranty.

The Towson High Stadium enjoys attendance of 8,000 to 10,000 spectators per year in addition field and track use by the local community. Currently there are 86 events held annually in the stadium, which is expected to increase to over 100 with the installation of a turf field. This is an additional fundraising project is currently in process under the Sports Boosters capital campaign program.

The new scoreboard has the capability to post information of events and news about Towson High School and the athletic program as well as recognize sponsors and donors such as the local recreation program, Towson Recreation Council (TRC) and the THS Alumni Association
