A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **General Provisions – Commemorative Days – South Asian American Heritage**
3 **Day**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to proclaim annually a certain day as South
5 Asian American Heritage Day; requiring the proclamation to urge certain
6 organizations to properly observe South Asian American Heritage Day with
7 appropriate programs, ceremonies, and activities; and generally relating to South
8 Asian American Heritage Day.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That Section(s) 7–411 through 7–413, respectively, of Article – General Provisions of the
22 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–412 through 7–414,
23 respectively.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read
25 as follows:

2 (A) THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROCLAIM ANNUALLY OCTOBER 2 AS SOUTH
3 ASIAN AMERICAN HERITAGE DAY.

4 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL
5 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE SOUTH ASIAN AMERICAN HERITAGE DAY PROPERLY
6 WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.

7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2015.
