A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Allegany County – Video Lottery Facilities – Distribution of Proceeds**

3 FOR the purpose of altering, for a certain fiscal year, the payment of the proceeds of video
4 lottery terminals at a video lottery facility in Allegany County; and generally relating
5 to the payment of the proceeds of video lottery terminals at a video lottery facility in
6 Allegany County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – State Government**

15 9–1A–27.

16 (c) (1) For the first 10 years of operations at a video lottery facility in Allegany
17 County, on a properly approved transmittal prepared by the Commission, the Comptroller
18 shall pay the following amounts from the proceeds of video lottery terminals at a video
19 lottery facility in Allegany County:

20 (i) 2% to the State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency for costs as
21 defined in § 9–1A–01 of this subtitle;

22 (ii) to the video lottery operation licensee, the percentage stated in
23 the accepted application for the location, not to exceed 50%;

1 (iii) 2.75% in local impact grants, in accordance with § 9–1A–31 of
2 this subtitle;

3 (iv) 2.5% to the Purse Dedication Account established under §
4 9–1A–28 of this subtitle;

5 (v) 0.75% to the Small, Minority, and Women–Owned Businesses
6 Account established under § 9–1A–35 of this subtitle; [and]

7 (vi) **IN FISCAL YEAR 2016, \$700,000 TO THE VIDEO LOTTERY**
8 **OPERATION LICENSEE; AND**

9 (VII) the remainder to the Education Trust Fund established under §
10 9–1A–30 of this subtitle.

11 (2) After the first 10 years of operations at a video lottery facility in
12 Allegany County, the proceeds generated at the facility in Allegany County shall be
13 allocated as provided in subsections (a) and (b) of this section.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
15 1, 2015.
