CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Gaming Payouts - Donation of Coins - Maryland Veterans Trust Fund

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission to adopt 4 regulations requiring authorizing certain video lottery facility licensees to adopt 5 certain procedures for certain players to donate coins to the Maryland Veterans 6 Trust Fund under certain circumstances; requiring the Commission to adopt 7 regulations requiring authorizing certain licensees to attach certain boxes near exits 8 in certain video lottery facilities for certain purposes; specifying the source of certain 9 revenues for the Fund; and generally relating to gaming payouts and revenues for 10 the Maryland Veterans Trust Fund.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 5 (d) The Commission shall adopt regulations that include the following specific 6 provisions in accordance with this subtitle:
- 7 (1) establishing the methods and forms of application that an applicant for 8 any license required under this subtitle shall follow and complete before consideration of 9 the application by the Commission;
- 10 (2) establishing the methods, procedures, and form for delivery of information from an applicant or licensee concerning any person's family, habits, character, associates, criminal record, business activities, and financial affairs;
- 13 (3) establishing the procedures for the fingerprinting of an applicant for 14 any license required under this subtitle or other methods of identification that may be 15 necessary in the judgment of the Commission to accomplish effective enforcement of the 16 provisions of this subtitle;
- 17 (4) establishing the manner and procedure of hearings conducted by the 18 Commission;
- 19 (5) establishing the manner and method of collection of taxes, fees, and 20 civil penalties;
- 21 (6) defining and limiting the areas of operation for video lottery terminals 22 and table games, rules of video lottery terminals and table games, odds for video lottery 23 terminals and table games, the types and values of promotional items that may be given 24 away to encourage play of video lottery terminals and table games, the method of operation 25 of the video lottery terminals and table games, and the number and types of table games;
- 26 (7) regulating the practice and procedures for negotiable transactions 27 involving players, including limitations on the circumstances and amounts of negotiable 28 transactions and the establishment of forms and procedures for negotiable instrument 29 transactions, redemptions, and consolidations;
- 30 (8) prescribing the grounds and procedures for reprimands of licensees or the revocation or suspension of licenses issued under this subtitle;
- 32 (9) governing the manufacture, distribution, sale, and servicing of video lottery terminals and table games;

- 1 (10)establishing the procedures, forms, and methods of management 2 controls: 3 providing for minimum uniform standards of accountancy methods, 4 procedures, and forms as are necessary to assure consistency, comparability, and effective disclosure of all financial information, including percentages of profit for video lottery 5 6 terminals and table games; 7 establishing periodic financial reports and the form of the reports, 8 including an annual audit prepared by a certified public accountant licensed to do business in the State, disclosing whether the accounts, records, and control procedures examined are 9 10 maintained by the video lottery operation licensee as required by this subtitle and the regulations that shall be issued under this subtitle; 11 12 requiring licensees under this subtitle to demonstrate and maintain (13)13 financial viability; 14 ensuring that the operation of video lottery terminals, table games, and video lottery facilities is conducted legally; 15 16 establishing procedures for the removal of video lottery terminals from 17 a video lottery facility; 18 (16)determining the suitability of: 19 the use of any variations or composites of the table games 20 authorized under this subtitle after an appropriate test or experimental period under terms 21 and conditions that the Commission may deem appropriate; and 22(ii) any other game that is compatible with the public interest and 23suitable for casino use after an appropriate test or experimental period deemed appropriate 24by the Commission; establishing procedures for accounting for all money exchanged at each 25(17)26 table game; 27 (18)establishing the number of video lottery terminals that may be removed 28 from a video lottery facility to accommodate table games: [and] 29 (19) REQUIRING AUTHORIZING LICENSEES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO:
- (I) ESTABLISH PROCEDURES TO OFFER PLAYERS THE OPPORTUNITY TO DONATE COINS, WHEN RECEIVING CASH ON PAYOUT, TO THE MARYLAND VETERANS TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 9–913 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND

1 2 3	(II) ATTACH DONATION BOXES NEAR THE EXITS FROM A VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY, WITH THE PROCEEDS DEDICATED TO THE MARYLAND VETERANS TRUST FUND; AND
4	[(19)] (20) otherwise carrying out the provisions of this subtitle.

6	(e) (2) There is a Maryland Veterans Trust Fund.
7	(g) The Fund consists of:
8 9	(1) gifts and grants that the Trust receives under § 9–914.2(a)(1) of this subtitle; and
10	(2) contributions to the Fund from:
11 12	(I) the sale of tickets from instant ticket lottery machines under § 9–112(d) of this title; AND
13 14	(II) THE DONATIONS FROM VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY PLAYERS UNDER § 9–1A–04(D)(19) OF THIS ARTICLE.
