3 **Requirement**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the minimum seating requirement for facilities for which a
5 certain Class B beer, wine, and liquor license may be issued in Dorchester County;
6 and generally relating to Class B beer, wine, and liquor licenses in Dorchester
7 County.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

17 19–902.

18 (a) There is a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license.

1 (b) The Board may issue the license for use by a restaurant, motel, or hotel that
2 has a facility:

3 (1) for serving full-course meals at least twice daily; and

4 (2) with seating at tables for at least [50] 25 individuals, not including
5 seats at bars or counters.

6 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at the
7 place described in the license for on-premises consumption.

8 (d) The annual license fee is \$1,000.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
10 1, 2016.
