## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County – Alcoholic Beverages – Special Event Festival Permit**

3 FOR the purpose of altering a requirement that an applicant for a special event festival  
4 beer, wine, and liquor permit in Calvert County demonstrate a certain expectation  
5 of attendance; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages permits in Calvert  
6 County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

22 14–102.

23 This title applies only in Calvert County.

1 (a) There is a special event festival beer, wine, and liquor permit.

2 (b) The Board may issue the permit to a license holder of a Class B or Class D  
3 license.

4 (c) Before the Board issues the permit, the applicant shall:

5 (1) demonstrate a reasonable expectation of attracting at least **[750] 250**  
6 customers to the special event; and

7 (2) commit to provide any additional security personnel required to be at  
8 the event for traffic, parking, and patrol purposes.

9 (d) Subject to the discretion of the Board, the permit authorizes the holder to  
10 operate additional bars or service counters for the sale and service of alcoholic beverages  
11 that are allowed under the holder's license:

12 (1) inside or outside the licensed premises; and

13 (2) for at least 1 day and not more than 3 consecutive days.

14 (e) The permit fee is \$100.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
16 1, 2016.
