A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Task Force to Study Access to Dental Care in the State**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study Access to Dental Care in the State;
4 providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a
5 member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the
6 reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to study and make
7 recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Task Force to report its
8 findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or
9 before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating
10 to the Task Force to Study Access to Dental Care in the State.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That:

13 (a) There is a Task Force to Study Access to Dental Care in the State.

14 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:

15 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of
16 the Senate;

17 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of
18 the House;

19 (3) the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, or the Secretary's
20 designee; and

21 (4) the following members, appointed by the Governor:

22 (i) one representative of the State Board of Dental Examiners;

- 1 (ii) one representative of the Maryland State Dental Association;
- 2 (iii) one representative of the Maryland Dental Hygienists'
3 Association;
- 4 (iv) one representative of the University of Maryland School of
5 Dentistry; and
- 6 (v) three dental care providers from organizations that serve
7 low-income populations.

8 (c) The Governor shall designate the chair of the Task Force.

9 (d) The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall provide staff for the Task
10 Force.

11 (e) A member of the Task Force:

12 (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Task Force; but

13 (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State
14 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

15 (f) The Task Force shall:

16 (1) study:

17 (i) how to increase preventive dental care utilization and decrease
18 unmet dental care need among Medicaid-eligible and Medicaid-ineligible children and
19 adults in the State;

20 (ii) the cost of dental care, including the effect of the increase in
21 Medicaid dental fees paid to providers and the increase in the Medicaid dental provider
22 network in the State in 2009;

23 (iii) how to address barriers to dental care, including financial issues
24 and the shortage of dentists and dental hygienists in the State; and

25 (iv) the effects of the Affordable Care Act on dental benefits coverage
26 and cost barriers to dental care; and

27 (2) make recommendations regarding how to increase access to dental care
28 among children and adults in the State.

29 (g) On or before December 30, 2016, the Task Force shall report its findings and
30 recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State
31 Government Article, the General Assembly.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
2 1, 2016. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June
3 30, 2017, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
4 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
