A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Child Abuse and Neglect – Failure to Report**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring an agency that is participating in a child abuse or neglect
4 investigation and that has substantial grounds to believe that a person has
5 knowingly failed to report child abuse as required under a certain provision of law
6 to file a certain complaint with a certain board, agency, institution, or facility; and
7 generally relating to child abuse and neglect.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Family Law**

16 **5–705.3.**

17 **IF AN AGENCY PARTICIPATING IN AN INVESTIGATION UNDER § 5–706 OF THIS**
18 **SUBTITLE HAS SUBSTANTIAL GROUNDS TO BELIEVE THAT A PERSON HAS**
19 **KNOWINGLY FAILED TO REPORT SUSPECTED ABUSE OR NEGLECT AS REQUIRED BY §**
20 **5–704 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE AGENCY SHALL:**

21 **(1) FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE APPROPRIATE LICENSING BOARD IN**
22 **ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE IF**
23 **THE PERSON IS A HEALTH PRACTITIONER;**

1 **(2) FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE APPROPRIATE LAW ENFORCEMENT**
2 **AGENCY IF THE PERSON IS A POLICE OFFICER; OR**

3 **(3) FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR**
4 **THE APPROPRIATE AGENCY, INSTITUTION, OR LICENSED FACILITY AT WHICH THE**
5 **PERSON IS EMPLOYED IF THE PERSON IS AN EDUCATOR OR A HUMAN SERVICE**
6 **WORKER.**

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2016.
