## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **City of Annapolis – Alcoholic Beverages – Refillable Container Permit for Draft**  
3 **Beer**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for the City of  
5 Annapolis to issue a refillable container permit for draft beer to a holder of a Class  
6 E license; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to refillable container  
7 permits in the City of Annapolis.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article – Alcoholic Beverages  
10 Section 10–1102  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (As enacted by Chapter \_\_ (S.B.\_\_)(6lr1406) of the Acts of the General Assembly of  
13 2016)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

17 10–1102.

18 (a) The Board may issue a refillable container permit for draft beer to a holder of  
19 a Class A license, [a]Class B license, [or a] Class D license, **OR CLASS E LICENSE.**

1 (b) An applicant for the permit shall complete the form that the Board provides.

2 (c) The hours of sale for a refillable container permit:

3 (1) begin at the same time as those for the underlying license; and

4 (2) end at midnight.

5 (d) The Board shall adopt regulations to carry out this section.

6 (e) The annual permit fees are:

7 (1) \$50 for an applicant whose license has an off-sale privilege; and

8 (2) \$500 for an applicant whose license does not have an off-sale privilege.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
10 1, 2016.
