2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Refillable Container Permits**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Frederick County
4 to issue a refillable container permit for draft beer and for wine to a holder of a Class
5 A alcoholic beverages license or a Class B alcoholic beverages license; providing for
6 certain permit fees; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Frederick
7 County.

4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
5 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

7 20–102.

8 This title applies only in Frederick County.

9 20–1101.

10 (a) The following sections of Title 4, Subtitle 11 (“Additional License Privileges”)
11 of Division I of this article apply in the County without exception or variation:

12 (1) § 4–1102 (“Corkage — Consuming wine not purchased from license
13 holder on licensed premises”); and

14 (2) § 4–1103 (“Removal of partially consumed bottle of wine from licensed
15 premises”).

16 (b) The following sections of Title 4, Subtitle 11 (“Additional License Privileges”)
17 of Division I of this article [do not] apply in the County:

18 (1) § 4–1104 (“Refillable container permit — Draft beer”), **SUBJECT TO §**
19 **20–1104 OF THIS SUBTITLE**; and

20 (2) § 4–1104 (“Refillable container permit — Wine”), **SUBJECT TO §**
21 **20–1105 OF THIS SUBTITLE**.

23 **(A) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A REFILLABLE CONTAINER PERMIT FOR DRAFT**
24 **BEER TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS A OR CLASS B LICENSE.**
