A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Mopeds and Motor Scooters – Failure to Carry Required Security – Penalty**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the maximum penalty for failure to carry evidence of the
4 required security while operating a moped or motor scooter.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
11 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article – Transportation**

13 17–104.1.

14 **(A)** The operator of a moped or motor scooter shall carry evidence of the required
15 security when operating the moped or motor scooter.

16 **(B) ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS**
17 **SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$50.**

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2016.
