## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Procurement – Department of General Services – Exemption for Historic**  
3 **Structures**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that certain provisions of law do not apply to procurement by  
5 the Department of General Services for the renovation of a structure built during  
6 certain centuries or listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic  
7 Places; and generally relating to exemptions from the procurement law.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
