## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Lottery Tickets – Internet Sales – Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency from  
4 allowing the establishment of any system or program that allows a person to  
5 purchase a State lottery ticket through an electronic device that connects to the  
6 Internet; and generally relating to the sale of State lottery tickets.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (E) THE AGENCY MAY NOT ALLOW THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ANY SYSTEM OR  
4 PROGRAM THAT ALLOWS A PERSON TO PURCHASE A STATE LOTTERY TICKET  
5 THROUGH AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE THAT CONNECTS TO THE INTERNET, SUCH AS A  
6 PERSONAL COMPUTER OR MOBILE DEVICE.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
8 October 1, 2017.
