- 16 (a) This section does not apply to compensation paid under Title 10, Subtitle 2 of

- 20 on the date of death survives in accordance with this section to the extent of [\$45,000]

HOUSE BILL 1294

- 1 (c) If there are surviving dependents of the covered employee, the right to compensation survives to the surviving dependents as the Commission may determine.
- 3 (d) If there are no surviving dependents of the covered employee and, on the date 4 of death, the covered employee had a legal obligation to support a surviving spouse, the 5 right of compensation shall survive to:
- 6 (1) the surviving spouse of the covered employee; or
- 7 (2) the surviving spouse and the surviving minor children of the covered 8 employee.
- 9 (e) If there are no surviving dependents and, on the date of death, the covered 10 employee did not have a legal obligation to support a surviving spouse, the right to 11 compensation survives only to the surviving minor children of the covered employee.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any claim arising from events occurring before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2017.
