Howard County Government via the Howard County Executive and Howard County Council. Through a memorandum of understanding, HCPSS has signed an agreement to both vacate the Harriet Tubman Building (currently used as a maintenance facility) and to sell the building to Howard County Government so that it may be preserved and used as a cultural, education and community center.

The Harriet Tubman School, which opened in 1949, served as the County's only all-black high until it closed through desegregation in 1965. For more than three decades it has been used for storage, office space and maintenance operations. This project includes: remediation of hazardous substances including asbestos, PCB, lead and fuel, removal of extraneous equipment, shelving, sub-walls, and restoration of the facility including flooring, walls, ceilings and other associated interior finishes. Provision of certain furniture and equipment is also included.
