1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education – Financial Aid – In–State Students**  
3 **(The Jill Wrigley Memorial Scholarship Expansion Act)**

4 FOR the purpose of making a certain individual eligible for certain financial aid if the  
5 individual is eligible for certain in–State tuition; and generally relating to financial  
6 aid for in–State students.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Education**

2 (a) Subject to subsection (d) of this section, each recipient of a Delegate Howard  
3 P. Rawlings Educational Excellence Award shall:

4 (1) Be accepted for admission in the regular undergraduate program at an  
5 eligible institution or be enrolled in a 2-year associate degree program in which the course  
6 work is acceptable for transfer credit for an accredited baccalaureate program in an eligible  
7 institution;

8 (2) **[Be] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 18-303.2 OF THIS SUBTITLE, BE** a  
9 resident of this State;

10 (3) Demonstrate to the Office a definite financial need; and

11 (4) Accept any other conditions attached to the award.

13 **NOTWITHSTANDING § 18-303(A)(2) OF THIS SUBTITLE, AN INDIVIDUAL IS**  
14 **ELIGIBLE FOR AN AWARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE**  
15 **FOR IN-STATE TUITION UNDER THIS ARTICLE.**

17 (c) A recipient of a part-time grant shall:

18 (1) **[Be] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 18-1401.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE, BE**  
19 a resident of the State; and

20 (2) Have demonstrated a definite financial need according to criteria  
21 established by the Commission.

23 **NOTWITHSTANDING § 18-1401(C)(1) OF THIS SUBTITLE, AN INDIVIDUAL IS**  
24 **ELIGIBLE FOR AN AWARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE**  
25 **FOR IN-STATE TUITION UNDER THIS ARTICLE.**

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
27 1, 2018.
