A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Foster Care Recipients and Unaccompanied Homeless Youth –**
3 **Employment Program**
4 **(Fostering Employment Act of 2018)**

5 FOR the purpose of establishing the Fostering Employment Program to provide
6 employment opportunities for certain foster care recipients and unaccompanied
7 homeless youth through training leading to certain credentials; requiring the
8 Department of Human Services and the Department of Labor, Licensing, and
9 Regulation jointly to supervise the Program; requiring the Department of Human
10 Services, in coordination with the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation,
11 to develop and implement the Program and coordinate with local departments of
12 social services and local workforce development boards; requiring the Program to
13 provide certain foster care recipients and unaccompanied homeless youth with
14 opportunities to obtain certain credentials through certain registered apprenticeship
15 programs or certain job readiness training; establishing that a certain foster care
16 recipient or unaccompanied homeless youth who meets certain requirements is
17 eligible to receive funding under the Program; authorizing the Department of
18 Human Services and the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation jointly to
19 adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the
20 Fostering Employment Program.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
8 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9 **Article – Human Services**

10 4–101.

11 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

12 (c) “Department” means the Department of Human Services.

13 **4–305.**

14 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
15 INDICATED.

16 (2) “CREDENTIAL” MEANS A RECOGNIZED:

17 (I) EDUCATIONAL DIPLOMA;

18 (II) CERTIFICATE OR DEGREE;

19 (III) OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE;

20 (IV) APPRENTICESHIP CERTIFICATE;

21 (V) INDUSTRY–RECOGNIZED CERTIFICATION; OR

22 (VI) AWARD FOR SKILLS ATTAINMENT AND COMPLETION,
23 ISSUED BY AN APPROVED TRAINING PROVIDER IN THE STATE OR THIRD–PARTY
24 CREDENTIAL PROVIDER.

25 (3) “FOSTER CARE RECIPIENT” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN §
26 15–106.1 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

27 (4) (I) “JOB READINESS TRAINING” MEANS TRAINING FOR THE
28 PURPOSE OF ASSISTING AND SUPPORTING JOBSEEKERS IN OVERCOMING

1 INDIVIDUAL BARRIERS TO EMPLOYMENT AND DEVELOPING THE SKILLS NECESSARY
2 TO MAINTAIN EMPLOYMENT AND TO QUALIFY FOR SKILLS TRAINING
3 OPPORTUNITIES.

4 (II) "JOB READINESS TRAINING" INCLUDES:

- 5 1. OCCUPATIONAL SKILLS DEVELOPMENT;
- 6 2. GED PREPARATION;
- 7 3. LITERACY ADVANCEMENT;
- 8 4. FINANCIAL STABILITY SERVICES, INCLUDING
9 FINANCIAL COACHING;
- 10 5. CREDIT COUNSELING; AND
- 11 6. ASSISTANCE IN MEETING TRAINING-RELATED
12 TRANSPORTATION AND CHILD CARE NEEDS.

13 (5) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE FOSTERING EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM
14 ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION.

15 (6) "REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM" MEANS A FORMAL
16 TRAINING PROGRAM APPROVED AND REGISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR,
17 LICENSING, AND REGULATION, OR BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
18 LABOR'S OFFICE OF APPRENTICESHIP.

19 (7) "TRAINING PROVIDER" MEANS AN ENTITY THAT:

20 (I) PROVIDES TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT SERVICES TO
21 INDIVIDUALS DESCRIBED IN § 11-504(B) OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT
22 ARTICLE; OR

23 (II) IS AWARDED A STRATEGIC INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIP GRANT
24 UNDER § 11-703 OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE.

25 (8) "UNACCOMPANIED HOMELESS YOUTH" HAS THE MEANING
26 STATED IN § 15-106.1 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

27 (9) "WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT AREA" MEANS A GEOGRAPHIC
28 AREA DESIGNATED BY THE GOVERNOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 106 OF THE
29 FEDERAL WORKFORCE INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT.

1 **(B) THERE IS A FOSTERING EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM.**

2 **(C) THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, LICENSING, AND**
3 **REGULATION SHALL JOINTLY SUPERVISE THE PROGRAM.**

4 **(D) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE EMPLOYMENT**
5 **OPPORTUNITIES FOR FOSTER CARE RECIPIENTS AND UNACCOMPANIED HOMELESS**
6 **YOUTH THROUGH TRAINING THAT LEADS TO INDUSTRY-RECOGNIZED**
7 **CREDENTIALS.**

8 **(E) THE DEPARTMENT, IN COORDINATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF**
9 **LABOR, LICENSING, AND REGULATION, SHALL:**

10 **(1) DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM; AND**

11 **(2) COORDINATE WITH:**

12 **(I) THE LOCAL DEPARTMENTS OF SOCIAL SERVICES; AND**

13 **(II) THE LOCAL WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARDS IN THE**
14 **STATE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT AREAS.**

15 **(F) THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE FOSTER CARE RECIPIENTS AND**
16 **UNACCOMPANIED HOMELESS YOUTH WITH OPPORTUNITIES TO OBTAIN**
17 **CREDENTIALS THROUGH:**

18 **(1) A REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM; OR**

19 **(2) JOB READINESS TRAINING.**

20 **(G) A FOSTER CARE RECIPIENT OR AN UNACCOMPANIED HOMELESS YOUTH**
21 **WHO IS NOT OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A TUITION EXEMPTION UNDER §**
22 **15-106.1 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FUNDING UNDER**
23 **THE PROGRAM IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS:**

24 **(1) AT LEAST 16 YEARS OF AGE; AND**

25 **(2) ENROLLED IN:**

26 **(I) A REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM; OR**

27 **(II) JOB READINESS TRAINING THROUGH A TRAINING**

1 PROVIDER FUNDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, LICENSING, AND
2 REGULATION.

3 (H) THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, LICENSING, AND
4 REGULATION JOINTLY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
6 1, 2018.
