A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Institutions of Higher Education – Family Members of Killed or Disabled**
3 **First Responders – Tuition Exemption**
4 **(Sean Suiter Act)**

5 FOR the purpose of exempting a family member of a certain first responder who was killed
6 or disabled in the line of duty from paying tuition and certain fees at a public
7 institution of higher education; defining certain terms; and generally relating to a
8 tuition exemption for a family member of a first responder killed or disabled in the
9 line of duty.

13 Annotated Code of Maryland

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Education**

18 **15–106.10.**

19 **(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS**
20 **INDICATED.**

21 **(2) “FAMILY MEMBER” MEANS A SPOUSE, DOMESTIC PARTNER, OR**
22 **CHILD.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(3) “QUALIFYING FIRST RESPONDER” MEANS A STATE OR LOCAL**
2 **FIREFIGHTER, EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, RESCUE SQUAD MEMBER, LAW**
3 **ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, CORRECTIONAL OFFICER, OR SWORN MEMBER OF THE**
4 **OFFICE OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL WHO, WHILE IN THE LINE OF DUTY, DIED OR**
5 **WAS DISABLED AND CAN NO LONGER WORK AS A FIRST RESPONDER.**

6 **(4) (I) “TUITION” MEANS THE CHARGES IMPOSED BY A PUBLIC**
7 **INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION FOR ENROLLMENT AT THE INSTITUTION.**

8 **(II) “TUITION” INCLUDES CHARGES FOR REGISTRATION AND**
9 **ALL FEES FOR CREDIT-BEARING AND NONCREDIT COURSES REQUIRED AS A**
10 **CONDITION OF ENROLLMENT.**

11 **(B) ANY FAMILY MEMBER OF A QUALIFYING FIRST RESPONDER IS EXEMPT**
12 **FROM PAYING TUITION AT A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.**

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
14 1, 2018.
