1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Transportation – Ignition Interlock Devices – Definition**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of “ignition interlock system” to require that an
4 ignition interlock device be equipped with a camera capable of recording the image
5 of the driver of the motor vehicle in which the device is installed; and generally
6 relating to ignition interlock devices.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Transportation**

15 21–902.2.

16 (a) In this section, “ignition interlock system” means a device that:

17 (1) Connects a motor vehicle ignition system to a breath analyzer that
18 measures a driver’s blood alcohol level; **[and]**

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1 (2) Prevents a motor vehicle ignition from starting if a driver's blood
2 alcohol level exceeds the calibrated setting on the device; AND

3 (3) HAS A CAMERA CAPABLE OF RECORDING THE IMAGE OF THE
4 DRIVER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE IN WHICH THE DEVICE IS INSTALLED.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2018.
