1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Social Organization**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain social organization in Harford County to seek
4 certain alcoholic beverages licenses under certain circumstances; requiring a social
5 organization seeking a license to meet certain criteria; authorizing a social
6 organization to sell alcoholic beverages during certain times; and generally relating
7 social organizations in Harford County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

2 This title applies only in Harford County.

3 22-909.

4 (a) There is:

5 (1) a 6-day Class C-3 (country club, **SOCIAL ORGANIZATION**, topiary
6 garden, or yacht or boat club) beer, wine, and liquor license; and

7 (2) a 7-day Class C-3 (country club, **SOCIAL ORGANIZATION**, topiary
8 garden, or yacht or boat club) beer, wine, and liquor license.

9 (b) The Board may issue the 6-day license or the 7-day license for use by:

10 (1) a country club that:

11 (i) may be operated for profit or not for profit;

12 (ii) has at least 75 members paying dues of at least \$50 per year per
13 member; and

14 (iii) maintains a regular or championship golf course of at least nine
15 holes or a swimming pool that is at least 20 by 40 feet;

16 (2) **A SOCIAL ORGANIZATION THAT:**

17 **(I) MAY BE OPERATED FOR PROFIT OR NOT FOR PROFIT;**

18 **(II) HAS AT LEAST 100 MEMBERS PAYING DUES OF AT LEAST**
19 **\$200 PER YEAR PER MEMBER;**

20 **(III) HAS AT LEAST 51% OF ITS MEMBERSHIP CONSISTING OF:**

21 **1. ACTIVE MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE**
22 **UNITED STATES;**

23 **2. VETERANS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED**
24 **STATES;**

25 **3. ACTIVE OR RETIRED POLICEMEN AND THE SPOUSES**
26 **AND CHILDREN OF THE ELIGIBLE MEMBERS UNDER ITEMS 1 THROUGH 3 OF THIS**
27 **ITEM;**

1 (IV) IS SECURED BY ELECTRONIC MEANS AND IS ACCESSIBLE
2 ONLY TO MEMBERS AND THEIR GUESTS OVER THE AGE OF 21;

3 (V) REQUIRES EACH SERVER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT
4 THE SOCIAL ORGANIZATION TO HOLD A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION FROM AN
5 APPROVED ALCOHOL AWARENESS PROGRAM AS DESCRIBED IN § 4-505 OF THIS
6 ARTICLE;

7 (VI) HAS PARKING FACILITIES TO ACCOMMODATE THE
8 VEHICLES OF MEMBERS AND THEIR GUESTS;

9 (VII) IS ZONED FOR BUSINESS OR COMMERCIAL USE; AND

10 (VIII) MAINTAINS A LIST OF ALL ACTIVE MEMBERS AVAILABLE
11 FOR REVIEW BY THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS.

12 (3) a topiary garden that:

13 (i) operates a public museum and garden for the members of the
14 topiary garden and the public as guests of the members;

15 (ii) is open to the public for at least 6 days a week for at least 6 hours
16 a day during at least 5 months each year; and

17 (iii) has food preparation facilities on the premises for the
18 convenience of guests; or

19 [(3)](4) a yacht or boat club that:

20 (i) may be operated for profit or not for profit;

21 (ii) owns real property in the county; and

22 (iii) has at least 150 dues-paying members, of whom at least 50 own
23 a yacht, boat, or other vessel.

24 (c) (1) The 6-day license authorizes the license holder to sell or provide beer,
25 wine, and liquor from Monday through Saturday at a club at the place described in the
26 license, for on-premises consumption by members and guests.

27 (2) The 7-day license authorizes the license holder to sell or provide beer,
28 wine, and liquor from Monday through Sunday at a club at the place described in the
29 license, for on-premises consumption by members and guests.

1 (d) (1) [The] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE
2 license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and days as set out under
3 § 22-2004(f) of this title.

4 (2) A SOCIAL ORGANIZATION GRANTED A LICENSE UNDER THIS
5 SECTION MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY, FROM
6 4 P.M. TO 11 P.M.

7 (e) (1) The annual fee for the 6-day license is \$1,300.

8 (2) The annual fee for the 7-day license is \$1,400.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
10 1, 2018.
