19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

4 (a) (1) Except as provided in § 12-2005 of this subtitle, a holder of a Class A
5 beer and light wine license may sell beer and light wine:

6 (i) on Monday through Saturday:

7 1. from 9 a.m. to ~~midnight~~ ~~10 P.M.~~ in the ~~Park Heights~~
8 ~~Redevelopment Area~~ AREA that is specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
9 the City in 2006; and

10 2. from 6 a.m. to midnight in all other locations in the City;

12 (ii) on the Sundays that fall between Thanksgiving Day and New

17 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a holder of a Class A beer,
18 wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:

19 (i) on Monday through Saturday:

20 1. from 9 a.m. to ~~midnight~~ ~~10 P.M.~~ in the ~~Park Heights~~
21 ~~Redevelopment Area~~ AREA that is specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
22 the City in 2006; and

23 2. from 6 a.m. to midnight in all other locations in the City;

25 (ii) on the Sundays that fall between Thanksgiving Day and New
26 Year's Day, from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m., if, on or before September 30 of that year, the license
27 holder has paid a supplementary license fee of \$75 for each Sunday the privilege is to be
28 exercised.

29 (c) Except as provided in § 12-2005 of this subtitle, a holder of a Class B-D-7
30 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:

1 (1) from 9 a.m. to ~~2 a.m. the following day~~ ~~10 P.M.~~ in the ~~Park Heights~~
2 ~~Redevelopment Area~~ AREA that is specified in the Park Heights Master Plan adopted by
3 the City in 2006; and

4 (2) from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in all other locations in the City.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
6 1, 2018.
