2 **Community Colleges – Veterans Advisors and Veterans Resource Centers –**
3 **Established**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain community colleges to employ a veterans advisor to
5 provide enrollment and advising services to certain students and to establish a
6 veterans resource center; and generally relating to veterans advisors and veterans
7 resource centers at community colleges.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 **16–109.**

17 **EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL:**

1 **(1) EMPLOY ~~AT LEAST ONE FULL-TIME~~ A VETERANS ADVISOR TO**
2 **PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE AND INTENSIVE ENROLLMENT AND ADVISING SERVICES**
3 **TO CURRENT AND PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS WHO ARE VETERANS; AND**

4 **(2) ESTABLISH A VETERANS RESOURCE CENTER ON CAMPUS TO:**

5 **(I) PROVIDE ACCESS TO FEDERAL AND STATE VETERANS**
6 **RESOURCES;**

7 **(II) SERVE AS A QUIET PLACE FOR VETERANS TO STUDY;**

8 **(III) ENABLE VETERANS TO CONNECT TO OTHER VETERANS,**
9 **HELPING THEM RENEW THE BONDS OF MILITARY SERVICE; AND**

10 **(IV) BE THE CENTRAL HUB FOR ALL ACTIVITIES ON CAMPUS**
11 **RELATED TO VETERANS.**

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
13 1, 2018.
