CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Transportation – Pride of Baltimore II – Funding *and Reporting***

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to include in the annual State budget an
4 appropriation of a certain amount from the Transportation Trust Fund *in certain*
5 *fiscal years* for the operation of the replica sailing vessel known as the Pride of
6 Baltimore II; *requiring a certain person or entity to submit a certain annual report to*
7 *the Department of Transportation and certain committees of the General Assembly;*
8 *providing for the termination of this Act;* and generally relating to operating funding
9 *and annual reporting* for the Pride of Baltimore II.

11 Article – Transportation

12 Section 2–801 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 8. Miscellaneous Grants”

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
4 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 Article – Transportation

6 SUBTITLE 8. MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS.

7 2-801.

8 ~~THE~~ (A) FOR FISCAL YEARS 2020 THROUGH 2023, THE GOVERNOR SHALL
9 INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET AN APPROPRIATION OF \$500,000 FROM
10 THE TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND FOR THE OPERATION OF THE REPLICA SAILING
11 VESSEL KNOWN AS THE PRIDE OF BALTIMORE II.

12 (B) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2019, AND ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1
13 EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, ANY PERSON OR ENTITY RECEIVING FUNDS UNDER THIS
14 SECTION SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT AND, IN ACCORDANCE
15 WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE SENATE BUDGET AND
16 TAXATION COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE THAT
17 INCLUDES:

18 (1) AN ACCOUNTING OF HOW THE FUNDS WERE EXPENDED,
19 SUPPORTED BY PROPERLY EXECUTED RECORDS, RECEIPTS, VOUCHERS, INVOICES,
20 AND CONTRACTS THAT EVIDENCE THE NATURE OF THE EXPENDITURES;

21 (2) AN ITINERARY AND ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT
22 DEMONSTRATES THAT THE PRIDE OF BALTIMORE II WAS OPERATED SOLELY FOR
23 THE PURPOSES OF PROMOTING HISTORICAL MARITIME EDUCATION, FOSTERING
24 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM, AND REPRESENTING THE CITIZENS OF
25 MARYLAND IN EVERY PORT VISITED; AND

26 (3) A STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN THAT INCLUDES:

27 (I) A GOAL TO DECREASE OR ELIMINATE THE NEED FOR STATE
28 FUNDS;

29 (II) AN ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET AND PLAN; AND

30 (III) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, THE ITINERARY OF THE
31 PRIDE OF BALTIMORE II.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
2 1, 2018. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of June 30, 2023, this
3 Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no
4 further force and effect.
