6 ~~Multi-Service Center~~ naming a certain plaza of the Mary E. W. Risteau District
7 Courts and Multi-Service Center in Harford County to be the H. Wayne Norman, Jr.
8 Memorial Plaza; providing for certain funding for the implementation of this Act;
9 requiring a certain administrative officer to ~~change certain signs to reflect the~~
10 ~~renaming of the Courthouse~~ add appropriate signage to reflect the naming of the
11 plaza; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the
12 ~~renaming of the District Courthouse located in Bel Air, Harford County~~ H. Wayne
13 Norman, Jr. Memorial Plaza.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

7 ~~COURTS AND MULTI-SERVICE CENTER IN HARFORD COUNTY, MARYLAND, SHALL~~
8 ~~BE RENAMED THE MARY E. W. RISTEAU AND H. WAYNE NORMAN, JR. DISTRICT~~
9 ~~COURTS AND MULTI-SERVICE CENTER NAMED THE H. WAYNE NORMAN, JR.~~
10 MEMORIAL PLAZA.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

12 (a) Funding for the implementation of this Act shall be as provided to the extent
13 funds are available in the budget of the Judicial Branch appropriated in the State Budget
14 for fiscal 2019.

15 (b) The Chief Administrative Clerk of District 9 – Harford County shall ensure
16 ~~the changing of the existing signs in the Courthouse to reflect the renaming of the District~~
17 ~~Courthouse located in Bel Air, Harford County, as the Mary E. W. Risteau and H. Wayne~~
18 ~~Norman, Jr. District Courts and Multi-Service Center~~ addition of appropriate signage to
19 reflect the naming of the plaza located on the south side of the Mary E. W. Risteau District
20 Courts and Multi-Service Center in Harford County as the H. Wayne Norman, Jr.
21 Memorial Plaza.

22 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
23 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has
24 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to
25 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
26 enacted.
