(St. Mary's County Delegation)

Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Per Diem Beer License Fee

This bill specifies that the fee for a Class C per diem beer license in St. Mary's County is \$10 per period for which the license is issued. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2018.**

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. The bill codifies existing practice.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law/Background: Under current law, the fee for a Class C per diem beer license, a Class C per diem beer and wine license, or a Class C per diem beer, wine, and liquor license is \$10 per day. St. Mary's County advises that it currently charges \$10 for the entire period for which a Class C per diem beer license is issued, and that the bill merely codifies current practice.

In fiscal 2017, there were 172 alcoholic beverages licenses issued in St. Mary's County.
