The monument will consist of a 30x30' slab with three (3) granite pieces. The center piece will be black granite stone in two parts. One will have a listing of Killed in Action veterans and this will be covered with an archway. The two grey granite stones to either side of the center piece will honor veterans who served in Vietnam and Vietnam War era veterans who served world-wide. There will be three (3) flag poles to the rear of the 30x30' slab. A walkway will run from the street to the main slab. The monument will be lit 24 hours a day.
